



POLICY – Conditional Admission

1. The Conditional Admission must be clear as to whether it is intended to address all or only some of the matters which are the subject of the inquiry. In presenting a Conditional Admission, the subject member is admitting to having engaged in the matters which are so named.
2. The Discipline Committee will review the Conditional Admission, and if it is acceptable to the Committee, shall suggest a penalty appropriate to the Committee.
3. The subject member will be advised of the decision of the Discipline Committee;
 - a. where the decision is to not accept the Admission, the hearing will proceed
 - b. where the decision is to accept the Admission and a penalty is suggested, the subject member will have an opportunity to accept or reject the penalty.
4. Where a penalty is suggested following acceptance of a conditional admission, and the subject member
 - a. does not accept the penalty, the hearing will proceed
 - b. accepts the penalty, the Conditional Admission and penalty will be published in a publication of the College and/or any other means deemed satisfactory to the Discipline Committee.
