The City of North Vancouver is the urban core of the beautiful North Shore and has a long-term vision to be “The Healthiest Small City in the World”, with five key priorities to be a City for People, a Liveable City, a Vibrant City, a Connected City and a Prosperous City.

The Planning and Development Department is looking for a regular full time Planner 2 to join their Environmental Sustainability team.

Reporting to the Deputy Director, Planning and Development, this is a senior position responsible for leading the advancement of significant Council Strategic Plan environmental priorities including development of the City’s new Environment Strategy. You will contribute your strategic guidance to the implementation of the Strategy’s priority actions and processes related to waste management, emission reductions, and ecosystem resilience while also effectively guiding the integration of the priorities within other business units at the City. As the senior planner within the team, you will be invaluable in applying your experience towards the advancement of key initiatives to guide the City in reaching its climate action targets. You will lead the team’s efforts for internal and external stakeholder engagement, including acting as staff liaison to the Climate & Environment Task Force council committee. You will oversee the collection of data and analytics for tracking corporate and community progress, make presentations to council and lead community engagements. Furthermore, you represent the team on major project working committees and comprehensive land use planning and regulatory modernization initiatives requiring input and guidance for on-going achievement of targets, goals and actions. In this role, you will be responsible for supervising and mentoring permanent staff and contributing to a strong culture of collaboration and inclusion.

You will have a University degree in an appropriate discipline, together with a post-graduate degree in Planning, Biology, Ecology or Environmental Engineering along with considerable related knowledge of municipal environmental planning, policy development and engagement processes for a broad range of public and stakeholder groups. Sound related experience in project management and the ability to facilitate collaborative decision-making, negotiation and interest-based problem solving is required. Supervisory experience at a professional level is also required. Membership or eligibility for membership in the Planning Institute of B.C., the Canadian Institute of Planners or a related professional association is required. A valid BC Class 5 Driver’s License is desirable. Attendance at evening Council, committee and public meetings is required for this role.

Shortlisted candidates may be required to complete standardized tests or exercises to demonstrate their applicable skills and knowledge.
