- Liaising with clients and regulators

- Preparing Erosion and sediment control (ESC) plans, Construction Environmental Management Plans (CEMP), Environmental Protection Plans (EPPs)
- Environmental monitoring on small- and large-scale construction projects
- Conducting fish and/or wildlife salvages
- Installing, inspecting, and maintaining erosion and sediment control devices

In addition, the candidate should have strong organizational skills, and effective relationship building skills with ability to work longer hours in a physically demanding environment, often with limited supervision. The candidate must also be comfortable with field work in remote locations and/or travel between DWB offices throughout BC. Additional assets or skills that will be considered include:

- Electrofishing, Swiftwater Rescue, and/or ATV/UTV Certification
- Experience operating 4x4 vehicles off-highway
