### Aquatic Specialist (Biologist / Biological Technologist)

The position requires the successful applicant to be based out of Campbell River, BC and will require travel to other areas of Vancouver Island and the adjacent mainland coast.

- We require an intermediate level candidate to cover a 1 year maternity leave. There is opportunity for this to continue as a permanent full time position.
- Responsibilities will be focused on fish and fish habitat assessments and environmental monitoring in freshwater environments, but could also include terrestrial or marine assessment work.

Candidates may be responsible for completing the following tasks, in addition to other work as needed, either independently or under the direct supervision of our Senior Biologists:

- Conducting biological and environmental assessments.
- Managing field data and preparing technical reports.
- Acting as an on-site environmental monitor at construction sites and instream projects.

#### **Desired qualifications:**

Candidates must be physically fit, able to work independently or as part of a team, be available for work at night and / or on weekends, and be comfortable working outdoors in all weather conditions. Camp work may be required. The ability to be flexible with scheduling at short notice is an asset.
