- Coordination of subcontracting specialties as required and supervising subcontractors for ground disturbance and utility location, borehole drilling, well installation and test pit excavation
- Assist with preparing and coordinating permit application, licenses, and approvals
- Provide support to other departments (survey, geotechnical engineering, materials testing, and civil engineering) to learn about and develop a holistic approach to project execution
- Prepare of Computer-aided design (CAD) drawings related to contaminated sites
