The Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy is responsible for the protection, management and conservation of BC's water, land, air and living resources. The ministry mitigates and manages the risks and consequences from climate change, including developing plans to set and meet carbon pollution reduction targets.

The Environmental Impact Assessment Biologist provides biological, chemical and other environmental impact assessment (EIA) support to legislated and other statutory decision makers by recommending effluent management and monitoring requirements for Environmental Management Act authorizations. This position designs, implements and assesses water quality monitoring programs for EIA studies and provides technical input on Environmental Assessment Act reviews.

- Registered Professional Biologist (RPBio) in BC and in good standing with the College of Applied Biology (CAB), or immediately eligible to transfer a current membership from an applicable jurisdiction to the CAB within six months of employment.
- Bachelor's Degree in Biology, Environmental Studies or various multi-disciplinary resource management studies, or other related fields, and 3 years of related experience; OR,
- Other relevant combinations of education and experience such as a Master's Degree in a related field, plus 2 years of related experience may be considered.
