NOTICE OF HEARING

TAKE NOTICE that a Discipline Panel of the College of Applied Biology of the Province of British Columbia will be convened on June 8, 2021 to conduct a Hearing by written submissions for the purpose of taking evidence and deliberating with respect to allegations described herein, pursuant to the College of Applied Biology's Rule 15 Investigation and Discipline.

AND TAKE NOTICE that the following allegations are made against you:

1. That you are in breach of paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 (The College of Applied Biology Member Code of Ethics) of the Rules of the College of Applied Biology by virtue of the fact that, in the preparation of a Construction Environmental Management plan (Project np. 12542-001) dated April 2018, and related work, you failed to meet the appropriate professional standard of care in relation to:
 - (a) sediment and erosion monitoring techniques;
 - (b) the use of an unusual method (mud wave) technique for excluding aquatic organisms;
 - (c) the standards for reports and data management for environmental monitoring; and
 - (d) the application of the correct Contaminated sites Regulation Standard.
2. That you are in breach of the College of Applied Biology's Rule 7.5 by failing to respond to requests for further information from the College in respect of the above allegations set out in the Citation issued October 26, 2020.

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Hearing by written submissions will proceed as follows:

1. April 15, 2021 - Service of the Notice of Hearing on the College
2. April 25, 2021 - Deemed Service of the Notice of Hearing on the Member
3. May 6, 2021 - Deadline for delivery by the College of its Statement of Points and associated documents ("SOP") to the Discipline Panel
4. May 17, 2021 - Deemed service of the College's SOP on the Member
5. June 7, 2021 - Deadline for delivery by the Member of her Statement of Points and associated documents to the Discipline Panel
6. June 8, 2021 - Discipline Panel Deliberations Begin

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that you, Shawna Reed, have the right, at your own expense, to be represented by counsel in respect of the above-mentioned Hearing by the Discipline Panel and that you or your counsel shall have the full right to make submissions and to present evidence in defence and reply in answer to the aforesaid allegations.

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in the event of your non-participation in the Hearing process as set out herein, the Discipline Panel may, upon proof of service of the Notice of Hearing upon you, proceed with the taking of evidence or otherwise ascertaining the facts concerning the said allegations, your absence notwithstanding, and may make its findings on the facts and its decision thereof without further notice to you.
