Interpretation Document: RETIRED REGISTRANTS AND VOLUNTEERING

This guideline provides clarity regarding Bylaw 5-8(1)(b) – Requirements for Registration as a Retired Registrant in which a registrant must submit *a declaration that the registrant is no longer practicing applied biology and does not intend to practice in the future.*

Interpretation

This bylaw does not preclude retired registrants from volunteering for organizations in which applied biology is a focus. However, retired registrants must not be offering professional advice which falls within the regulated and reserved practice of applied biology as defined in the *Applied Biologists Regulation*.

Where an individual or organization is going to rely on the professional advice provided, that information may only be provided by an active registrant within their scope of practice
